 - **★** For (A) and (H):
 - transfer of JAR-FCL
 - * For other aircraft (PL) and (As):
 - → ICAO Annex 1
 - → National requirements
 - → Proposals of experts

Commercial licences – where to find the requirements

Organisation of Subparts:

- **★ Common Requirements, e.g.:**
 - Minimum age
 - Privileges and conditions
 - → Theoretical knowledge
 - → Flight instruction
 - → Skill test
- **★** Specific Requirements for an aircraft category
 - → Aeroplane (A)
 - → Helicopter (H)
 - Powered-lift (PL) *
 - Airship (As) *
 - * New requirements, not transferred from JAR-FCL

What is new?

Instruction outside EU territory

- → Requirements in old Appendix 1 to JAR-FCL 1.300 have disappeared – same requirements as for instruction in EU
- Level playing field



Instructors - summary

- Subpart J (cont.)
 What is new?
 - **★ New types of instructor:**
 - → MI
 - → MCCI for helicopters
 - **→ LAFI**
 - instructor for the LPL
 - ★ FI privileges and conditions
 - Include new categories of aircraft
 - CPL TK is not needed for FI (A)



Instructors - summary

Subpart J (cont.)
What is new?

- * Prof check for revalidation:
 - LAFI: every third revalidation
 - FI: for the first and at least every
 - →Second revalidation for (A) and (H)
 - Third revalidation for (As), (S) and (B)

- Subpart K
 - ★ Follows JAR-FCL for (A) and (H), with a similar system for other categories of aircraft

What is new?

- Examiners no longer work on behalf of NAA
 - They have their own privileges
 - More detailed requirements on qualifications, obligations and limitations
- All examiners need to have a licence
- ★ Special authorisation
 - Only for introduction of new aircraft types



Summary

- How to become a professional pilot?
 - →The traditional way:
 - → Modular route
 - » PPL course, CPL course, IR course, ATPL theoretical knowledge course and many hours of flight and tests.
 - →Integrated route
 - » ATP integrated course, resulting in the issue of a CPL and IR and ATPL Theory

- How to become a professional pilot?
 - The latest developments and alternative way for aeroplanes:
 - → The Integrated Multi-Crew Pilot Licence (MPL(A)) course.
 - → Resulting in a MPL(A) with Multi-Pilot Type Rating and ATPL theory
